What did grantees provide to victims of domestic violence in fiscal year 2022-2023?

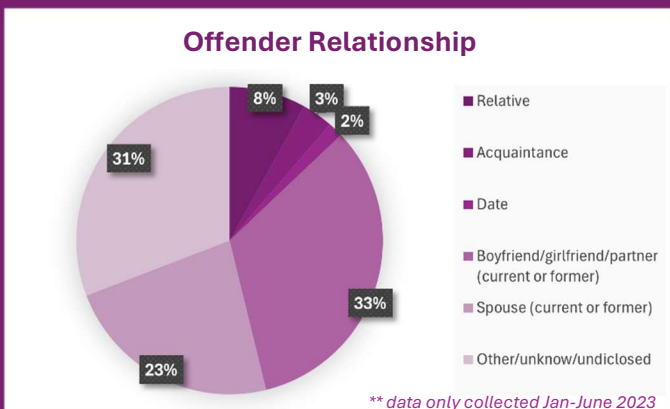
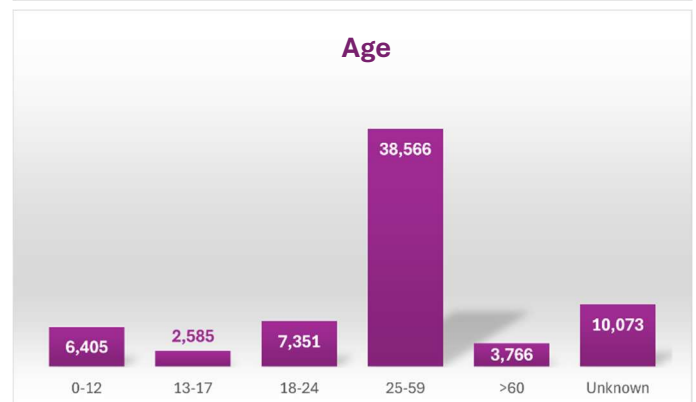
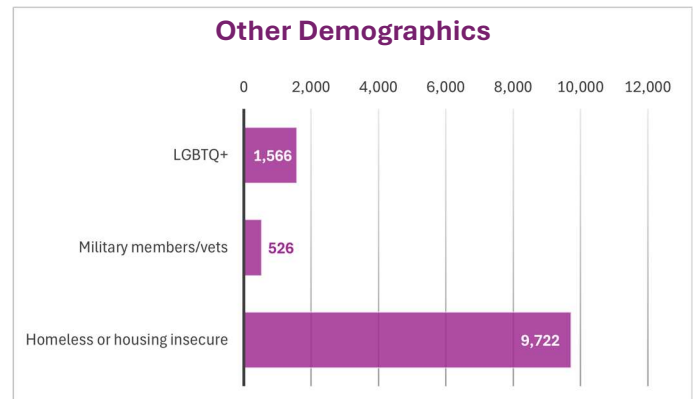
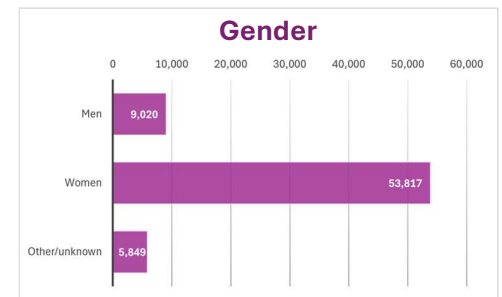
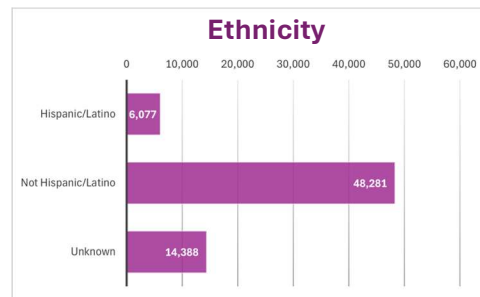
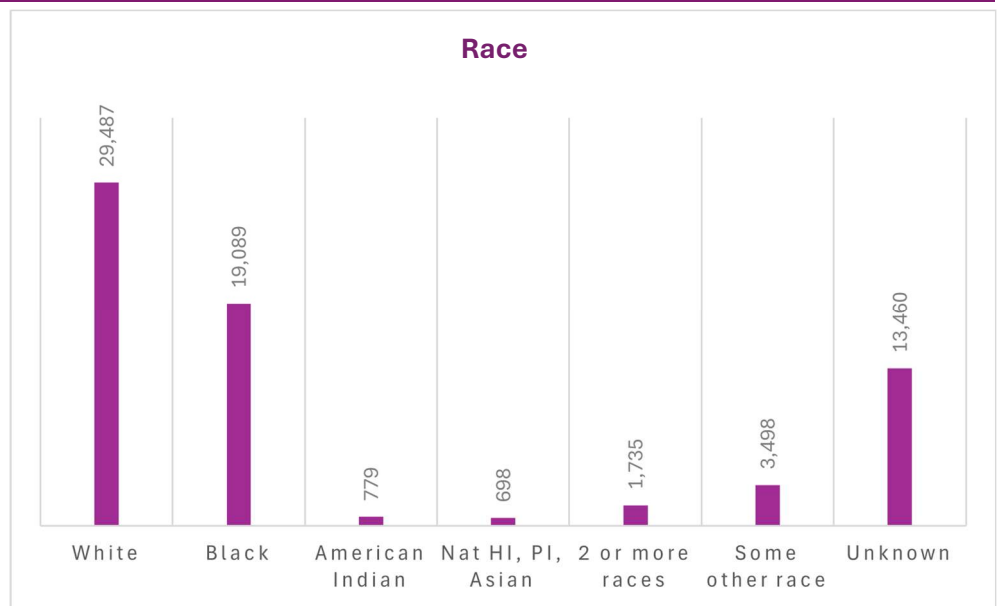
