- 1. Applicants must be American Indian and enrolled in a state or federally recognized tribe in the State of North Carolina.
- 2. Applicant must be an incoming freshman enrolling in a two year or four year college or university, and/or freshman, sophomores, juniors or seniors who are enrolled and still attending a two-year or four-year college or university.
- 3. Applicants must be enrolled as full-time students.
- 4. "Application" means a complete application form with the supporting documentation as listed on pages 3 and 4. Only completed applications will be accepted for consideration. Incomplete applications will be discarded. FAXED OR E-MAIL APPLICATIONS OR DOCUMENTATION WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.
- 5. Applicants must apply for all other sources of funding for which they are eligible.
- 6. Applications will be competitive. We expect to award five, \$500.00 scholarships for the fall of 2011.
- 7. The screening committee will use a point system to score the applications on academic achievement, grade point average, career plans, American Indian activities, extracurricular activities, community involvement, references and essay.

# 8. <u>Applications must be received in my office by 5:00 p.m. on or before:</u> Friday, February 18, 2011.

- 9. Winners will be announced March 10-12, 2011 at the North Carolina Indian Unity Conference, North Raleigh Hilton, Raleigh, North Carolina. Presentation of scholarship awards is tentatively scheduled for Saturday morning, March 12.
- 10. A student who has received the United Tribes Scholarship once will not be eligible to receive it again in any category.
