### **SECTION 8 HOUSING PROGRAM:**

Mr. Greg Richardson made a recommendation to include the following Veteran Initiative in the Administrative Plan.

1-Veterans Administration Supportive Housing (VASH) Program Approval, to amend the Administrative Plan for the Section 8 Program as follows:

1. Under 3-III.C. of our Administrative Plan, we will add the following paragraph at the end of the first PHA (Public Housing Authority) Policy: "In the cases of VASH voucher holders, we will follow VASH policy on eligibility denial."



2. We will add the following language to section 4-III-D. of our administrative plan. "The NC Commission of Indian Affairs has entered into an agreement with the Durham Veterans Administration to administer the VASH program. We will provide immediate briefings to VASH referrals."

#### **COMMENTS FROM COMMISSION MEMBERS:**

> Commissioner Tony Hayes made a motion to approve the amendment to the Administrative Plan to include the Veterans Administration Supportive Housing (VASH) Program. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Larece Hunt. Motion carried.
