

NCGS § 20-39.1. outlines how publicly owned vehicles are to be marked and the qualifications for having private license plates on publicly owned vehicles. Private Plates are only issued to state-owned vehicles meeting the criteria in the law.

Vehicle qualifies for private plates because:
