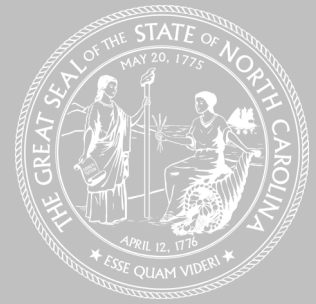


James E. Cofield Jr.

Prior to this role, Cofield served as president and chief executive officer of Malmart Mortgage Company, Inc. Malmart was a full-service mortgage banking firm which provided permanent and construction financing to both residential and commercial real estate markets throughout New England.

Cofield served as a director, vice president, and member of the executive committee of the Greater Boston Chamber of Commerce; a director of the Greater Boston Real Estate Board; and a director of the Massachusetts Association of Realtors.

He is a past president and a member of the Board of Governors of the Massachusetts Mortgage Bankers Association; he served a five-year term as a gubernatorial appointee to the Board of the Boston Redevelopment Authority; and was a trustee of Charlestown Savings Bank and Newworld Bank.
